Requirements for serving positions:

- 1. Completion of PATH class.
- 2. Arrival 30 minutes prior 1st service (to attend Dream Team Huddle).
- 3. Arrival 15 minutes prior to 2nd service.
- 4. First service: Encourage to attend the Dream Team Huddle at 8:30am.
- 5. Knowing the Compass North Valves.
- 6. Plugged into Slack Hospitality Team group thread for

updates, relevant information, staying connected to events and PCO. Must download Slack and Planning Center online on your smartphone or can be utilized directly on your desktop. 7. Encourage to complete the Leadership Pipeline 1 & 2.

Courses Include:

Videos/Questionnaires, and comments, once LP1& LP2 is completed, a reward is given.

8. Encourage to join or lead a life group each quarter semester.

Compass North Church Serving Positions Introductory Position: Hospitality Team Member -Connection Table Key Responsibilities:

- Arrive 15 – 20 minutes prior to service starting to help answer guest's questions.

- Make sure all connection cards/ prayer request cards have been received and placed in the connection card bin.

- Replenish mints for connection table and restrooms.

- Be mindful chatting with friends/ peers while serving. Although, we want to have a "whole lot of fun" we also do not want to miss an opportunity with a new guest experience. Ask yourself, "what is my God assignment today?"

- Replenish new guest bags if supplies are low. All supplies will be in the closet.

 Introduce yourself by name to new guests or to any guest you don't know. Get to know new guests! How did they hear about CNC?
Tell them your story! Be excited for our new guests and engage in conversation and hand out a new guest bag!

- Be available to answer questions guests may have.

- Be available to assist the Team leader in other areas if needed.

- Be familiarized with upcoming events prior to service to provide accurate info to guests.

- At close of service (when pastor asks everyone to stand) be at connect table to be available for early exiting guests.

Compass North Church Serving Positions Introductory Position: Hospitality Team Member -Aisle Host Key Responsibilities:

- What is my God Assignment today?

- Be available to engage in conversation and greet guests prior to service. Work on the 20/20 (Engage with guests 20 minutes before service and 20 minutes after service) Introduce yourself by name to new guests or to any guest you

don't know. Get to know new guests! How did they hear about CNC? Tell them your story! Be excited for our new guests and engage in conversation

- Be at assigned Aisle prior to the 5-minute countdown begins prior to service starting, engage in conversation to guests in your assigned aisle.

- Always face the entrance doors and be attentive, so each guest can be seated as quickly as possible.

- Always be available to help guests find a seat.

- Have a smiling face.

- Walk down the aisle from time to time to see where any empty seats are available once sanctuary seats have been filled to help last minute guests

- When the MC's announces aisle hosts to come up, have black buckets ready to come up to the first aisle and pass buckets to the right of you.

- Face the back of the sanctuary and when the announcement video begins to play, start passing the buckets to the right of you.

- When you reach the back of the sanctuary, hand the buckets to Pastor Gary.

_____Guest Aware: Whether serving or not, I will be mindful of new guests & introduce myself, help them find whomever invited them, introduce them to someone at Connect Center.

_____Serving is working for God. I will remind myself and politely delay non-serve related conversations until after I am finished serving.

Church Aware: A clean environment is part of our guests impression of Compass North church. I will pick up and dispose of empty coffee cups & water bottles. If I see a spill or mess of any kind, I will clean it up or bring it to the attention of someone who can.

____I understand I am expected to participate in trainings/meetings/and Dream team parties.
