

- 4. Dress modestly and fashionably

- 5. Mingle with guests 20min before/after service (20/20)
  - We are truly BIG on relationships at CNC and we want our guests to know that! We try to say "Hi" to at least one person we don't know each service.
- 6. We serve in both services when scheduled

Remember to be stationed at the fresh start table at the end of each service.

7. Respond to PCO/Slack messages within 24hrs

Stage presence is crucial to engaging our congregation in authentic communication. Let's push ourselves out of our comfort zones and have fun while we are speaking!
