Culture

- A worship team that is godly, talented, mature Christ followers who know God, find freedom, discover their purpose, and make a difference!
- We are FAMILY. Brothers and sisters in Christ.
- A worship team moving in the same direction together as a church and a team.
- Seek to honor God in every aspect of our lives.
- Daily spending time in His Word and being deeply committed to love and serve God's church faithfully.
- Desire to pursue purity and godliness, with a humble servant's heart.

Spiritual Leadership - We desire to lead our church through worship to know God better and in a more intimate and personal way.

- High level of commitment and responsibility to lead a congregation not only in song, but our daily lives.
 - Living as Biblical and Godly examples:
 - Free from addictions and drug use.
 - Showing the love of Christ in all areas of our lives (work, school, home, community, and social media).
 - Be examples of the fruit of the spirit in relationships.
 - Be uplifting and the light to all who are around you.

Personal Growth - We care about your heart as a member of the worship team.

- Encourage one another as a community to stay plugged in beyond Sunday morning.
- Attending Sunday church services regularly (even when you are not serving).
- PATH class - You need to complete PATH class to become part of the worship team.
- Worship Life Group - We would like you to attend the "Worship" life group and gatherings when available
- We ask that you complete the Freedom Group within 1 year of joining the worship team.
- Take part in worship team worship nights or family nights.
- Scheduling - You will not serve more than three times a month

Musical Ability - It is important that we play skillfully to the Lord

- As a team we do our best when we are serving to minimize distractions during worship by being prepared.
- Pursue growth in musical ability (together as a team and individually)
- If using a device, it should not be a distraction during service.

Dress Code - Eliminate distractions that would hinder others from worshipping God

- There is a designated color for each week. If you do not have that color wear black.
- Model modesty and dress for worshipping Jesus (not sloppy)
- NO overly tight clothing (nothing that hugs the curves)
- NO sleeveless tops (without a covering)
- NO revealing clothing
 - This includes: high waisted pants and clothes that do not cover the midriff
 - Dresses/skirts must be within 3 inches of the knee.
- All clothing must represent our values as a church.
 - No political rhetoric, distracting logos, or secular bands.
- No slides or flip-flops

Look in the mirror and watch what you look like - jump, clap, bow, dance, raise your hands, be engaging. If something looks awkward or revealing..... please adjust your dress for all focus to be on Jesus.

Communication - Communication helps make our time fruitful and productive

- All communication will be through the Slack app. If you need help with Slack please see one of the Lead Team members.
- All scheduling requests and conflicts will be handled by the music director.
- All changes in the normal schedule will be communicated in the Slack app.
- Scheduling will all be through Planning Center Online (PCO).
 - Response required within 24 hours
 - Block out dates need to be input to PCO by the first Thursday of the month for the next month.
 - Ex. Your block out dates for November need to be in PCO by the first Thursday in October.
- The worship channel on Slack is for all open communication and new worship songs. It is not for scheduling.

Practice

- Practices are Thursday evenings. *see Thursday evening schedule attached
- Thursday practices are mandatory for participating in Sunday service.
- All members of the worship team are required to stay through the devotion after Thursday night practice.

Be READY! - We value leading worship from a heart that overflows with the joy and love of Jesus

- Please do your absolute best to make worshipping a priority in your life, and take time to prepare your heart for a Jesus encounter on Sunday mornings
- Be PRAYED UP upon arrival... let's encourage each other so that we can lead the congregation and others



CNC WORSHIP Weekly Schedule

THURSDAY

6:40pm	All team members arrive to set up instruments/equipment and prepare for practice	
7:00 - 7:30pm	Band- practices together	Vocalists- practice separate from band
7:30 - 8:30pm	Band and Vocalists practice together	
8:30 - 9:00pm	Devotional and Prayer	

SUNDAY (If service starts at 9:00. Here is an example of our schedule.)

7:15am	Arrive and prepare instruments/equipment
7:30am	Warm up and run through of the entire set
8:30am	Dream Team huddle
8:30-8:50am	20/20 - meet and greet to grow and strengthen Godly relationships
8:50am	All CNC Worship TEAM in the Green Room - prayer and final prep for the service
8:55am	Be on Stage- READY to lead the congregation in worship to Jesus

- Times may change depending on how many services we have scheduled.
