MISSIONS

Convoy of Hope

Multiple initiatives are taken on by Convoy of Hope. We're glad to support such a focused organization that helps out in so many ways. We supply a portion of external giving to Convoy of Hope so that disaster relief and agriculture efforts can be lifted to help people and communities all around the world.

We're entering another year of our support for feedONE. Currently **our church feeds 119 kids every month** with vital nutrients. We do what we can with what we have so that people may know the love of Jesus. Convoy of Hope was also pivotal in supplying relief efforts for the war in Ukraine. As war broke out, many fled across neighboring borders. Convoy of Hope was quick in their response to help refugees with essentials.

Association of Related Churches (ARC)

The Association of Related Churches (ARC) is a church-planting and coaching organization. Compass North Church was an ARC church plant and to date they have planted over 1,000 churches. **In 2022, they planted 63 churches.**

FireBible

Printed in 63 languages, FireBible is making the word of God available to as many people as possible, especially in nations least reached by the Gospel. They have people working around the clock printing Bibles, many of which will face persecution once they are discovered in their country.

Church Boom

Church Boom is all about pastors coaching pastors. Led by Pastor Chris Sonksen, Church Boom has a network of pastors who are available for pastors who are struggling. **Church Rescue is designed to help churches** with financial assistance, free ministry events, and personalized coaching. **Around 10,000 churches each year close their doors** for the last time. With Church Rescue, we can help reduce this number.

Better Together Collaborative

In recent years, we've seen God move in our community through local partnerships. We have always been a supporter of how others are being used to advance the Kingdom of God, and this year we would like to **further help organizations** doing great work. The list of efforts for the collaborative include: South Street Ministries, Hope United, Relentless 330, RAHAB Ministries, Bridges Learning Center, A Walk In Their Shoes, and Recovery Friendly Congregation.

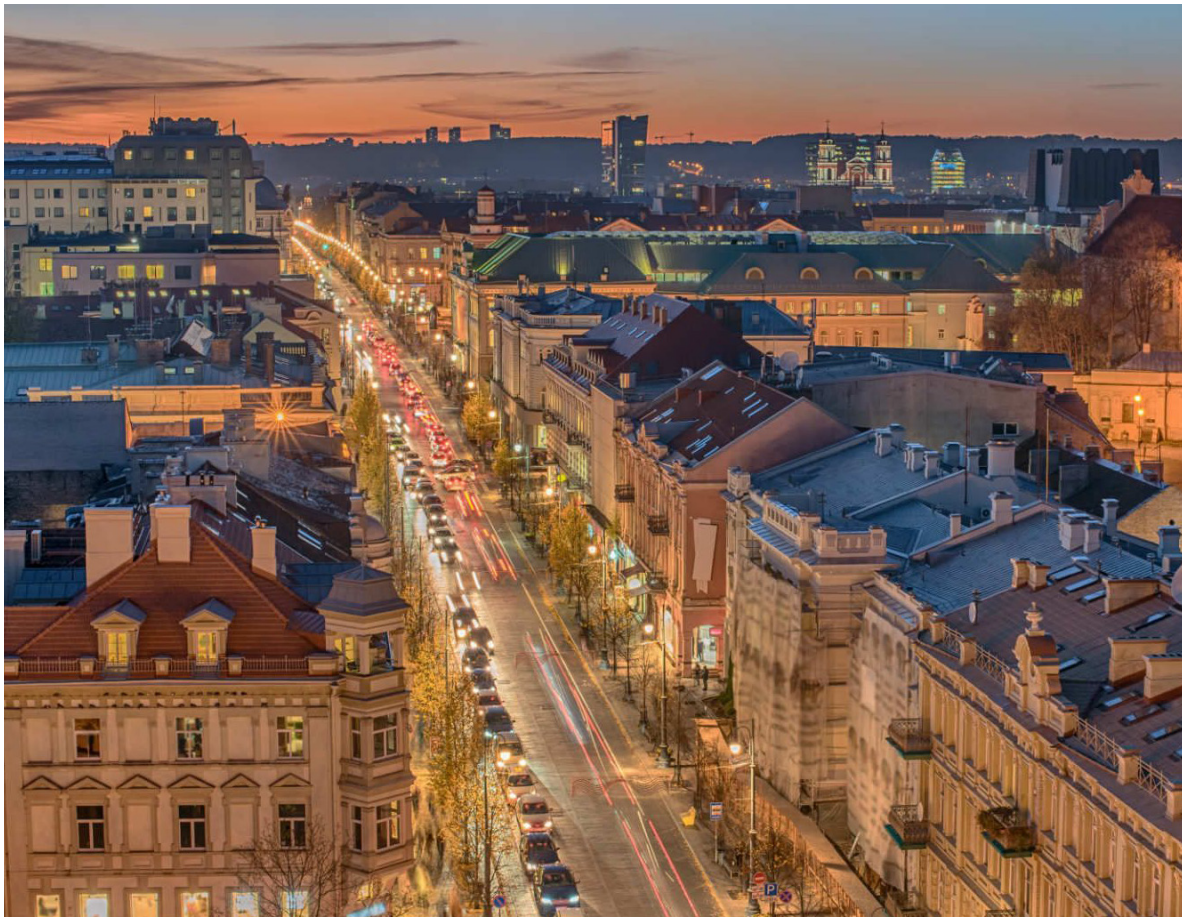

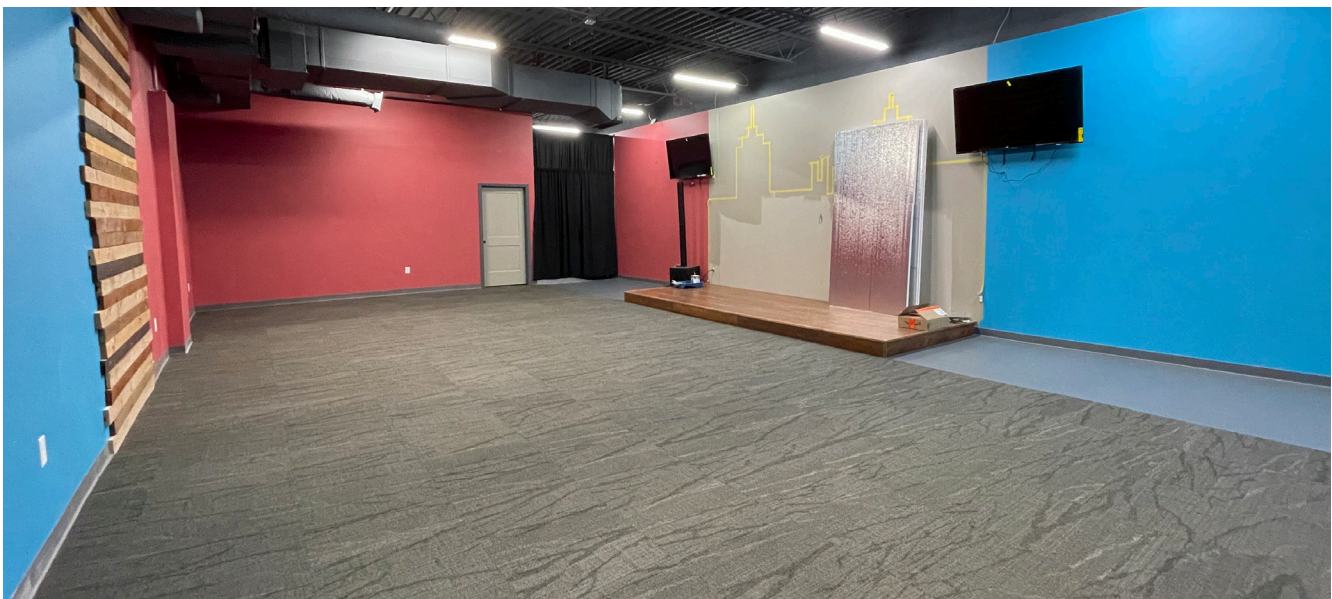
NEXT GENERATION

God is not a forcer, He is a space-filler. Since Compass North Church was launched in 2013, this has been proven true over and over. We initially launched in the ballroom of the Holiday Inn in Fairlawn, Ohio. The strain of setting up church weekly grew on our team, and Pastor Joe believed that God was going to give us a building. What seemed to be out-of-the-blue turned true six months later when we moved into a building at 2445 S Arlington Road in Akron. This building was a blessing from a church that used to have services and was turned over to Compass North.

We quickly grew with a permanent location, and soon launched a second service, followed by a third service. God was growing His church, and we sought after a new space where He can continue to send people. We were fortunate enough to move into more than 20,000 square feet of space which was built out for us with a plan that we could grow into. On the next page features some of the mock-ups of that space as that plan was launched to the church.

God's not done working. He's continuing to send people and providing ample opportunity for ministry as we seek Him in direction. Our Campus Development & Growth fund will be set up to secure future development of a new space where we can continue to grow and launch campuses from-all so that God would be given the glory of building His church.

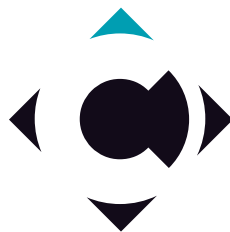
